- (iii) **Eligibility:** Class XII Pass with minimum 45% of marks
- (iv) **Intake Capacity:** 120 Students +14 Special Category Seats

"Fifty percent of the total seats of a particular discipline of study shall be reserved for residents of Jharkhand State or those who have passed the qualifying examination from the institutions located in Jharkhand State and to the wards of the Employees of the Central/State Government/University/Public Undertaking/Corporations/Boards/Aca demies, etc. working in Jharkhand State. Reservation policy in this regard shall be applicable for admission against these seats."

The candidates are required to undertake a coursework for a minimum period of one semester, covering 12 credits, the details of which are as follows:

- 1. Research methodology course: 4 credits
- 2. Research and Professional Ethics: 4 credits
- 3. Teaching Assignment and Research paper: 4 credits

A Ph.D. scholar must obtain a minimum of 55% marks in the course work to be eligible to continue in the programme and submit his or her thesis.
