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A Word About IUER

The Bar Council of India through its Trust, after having successfully established the National Law School of India University, Bangalore in 1986, in the year 2022, has established the India International University of Legal Education and Research, Goa, [IIULER] to bring about the next landmark revolution in the field of legal Education.

The first revolution was by way of introduction of the 5 year Integrated Law Degree course through NLSIU, Bangalore, which is now a rage amongst students. This revolution by the name of IIULER is set to harmonize, amalgamate and integrate theory, research, clinical/practical training, legal skill acumen, aptitude & social consciousness amongst its students, as never witnessed before, in the landscape of Indian Legal Education. This can make them emerge as fully equipped with all tools to practise law and/or to pursue higher studies and/or to appear in judicial exams, job interviews in Govt. and/ or pvt. in firms and corporate offices etc. on the day they graduate.

There has been a growing demand from all corners of the Society to take steps for uplifting the standards of legal education in the country. Bar Council of India, being the regulator of legal education, was/is concerned about such a demand. Making a policy or giving only suggestions and/or directions for improving legal education is not sufficient. Bar Council of India, therefore, decided to establish a model University of International standards which can be observed and followed by other law teaching institutes.

This 'Gen-Next' institution strives to meet Global academic standards and nurture leaders of tomorrow with its innovative use of clinical learning methods by establishing a connect between academic legal studies and actual implementation of law. All modern subjects and techniques with practical experiential learning will be available in the University. Apart from providing rock solid academic foundation, the academic teaching, here, will be interlinked and well connected with Bar and the Bench. The institution also believes that adherence to academic and personal conduct, based on integrity, honesty and fairness, is also essential to nurture the budding lawyers of tomorrow.



Evolution of Legal Education in India

Timeline

Upto 1950

1857 – Universities of Calcutta, Madras & Bombay started teaching of law subjects. 1948 – Radhakrishnan Commission assessed the state of University Education and made its recommendations for improvement.

1951 to 1960

Radhakrishnan Committee's recommendations had its impact on law education as well. 14th Law Commission remarks – "plethora of half-baked lawyers, who do not know even the elements of law and who are let loose upon society as drones and parasites in different parts of the country."

1961 to 1986

1961 – Bar Council of India was entrusted with the responsibility of Legal Education. BCI started setting standards for Legal Education for 3 year LL.B. Degree courses and in 1986 established National Law School of India University, Bengaluru, as a model law school with an innovative Five-year Integrated Programme. The unique experiment of National Law School of India University, Bengaluru, succeeded in bringing condense and self-esteem to legal education.

1998 to 2022

The era of National Law Universities started in India with the establishment of second National Law University, i.e. NALSAR, Hyderabad, in 1998, which was followed by a flurry of National Law Universities (23 and still counting). As of now, BCI has established, not only a National but also a truly International University in the name & style of INDIA INTERNATIONAL

UNIVERSITY OF LEGAL EDUCATION & RESEARCH, at GOA, INDIA, in the year 2021-2022.

IIULER is established by Goa Government by way of an enactment known as India International University of Legal Education & Research of the Bar Council of India Trust at Goa Act (Act No. 16 of 2021) and the University takes pride to be the first International Law University established by the Bar Council of India Trust.

Scholarship for UG Students

- Candidates enrolled in the 5-year Integrated LL.B. course who score 60% and above in CLAT are eligible for various levels of tuition fee reduction as follows:
 - 1. 90% and Above in CLAT: The adjusted tuition fee is Rs. 4,28,121.87 for the first year, with a total annual fee of Rs. 7,24,121.87. The fee from the second year onwards is Rs. 6,24,121.87 per year. The total fee for 5 years is Rs. 32,20,609.35.
 - 2. 80% and Above in CLAT: The adjusted tuition fee is Rs. 4,51,812.50 for the first year, with a total annual fee of Rs. 7,47,812.50. The fee from the second year onwards is Rs. 6,47,812.50 per year. The total fee for 5

years is Rs. 33,39,062.50.

- 3. 70% and Above in CLAT: The adjusted tuition fee is Rs. 4,76,750 for the first year, with a total annual fee of Rs. 7,72,750. The fee from the second year onwards is Rs. 6,72,750 per year. The total fee for 5 years is Rs. 34,63,750.
- 4. 60% and Above in CLAT: The adjusted tuition fee is Rs. 5,04,000 for the first year, with a total annual fee of Rs. 8,00,000. The fee from the second year onwards is Rs. 7,00,000 per year. The total fee for 5 years is Rs. 36,00,000.
- Special scholarship scheme for students of Goa upto 20 percentage of reserved seats for them.
- University will announce scholarship policy at the beginning of each academic year.
- Performance-Based Adjustments: Scholarships will be reviewed annually and may be adjusted based on performance.
- EWS Concessions: Candidates from the Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) category who achieve 75% or higher in CLAT may receive a 50% tuition fee reduction, subject to an interaction with the IIULER committee. Additional reductions may be granted at the Chancellor's discretion, based on economic conditions and merit.

- Foreign Nationals are not eligible to appear for CLAT.
- For NRI/NRI Sponsored/Foreign National seats, applicants are advised to contact the university via email at info@iiuler.edu.in or visit the website for more details.



- There is no upper age limit for candidates appearing for UG Programme through the CLAT 2025.

• Candidates who have passed in 10+2 or an equivalent examination with a minimum

of:

i. Forty five percent (45%) of marks or its equivalent in grade





- The result of the qualifying examination (i.e., 10+2) shall be submitted by the candidate at the time of admission, failing which the candidate shall be ineligible for admission to the course they may have applied for.
- Candidates appearing for the qualifying examination in March/ April, 2025 are also eligible to apply. However, they shall be required to produce an evidence of their passing the qualifying examination at the time of admission, failing which they shall lose their right to be considered for admission.
- If more than one candidate secures an equal number of marks in the CLAT 2025, the brook of tio shall be by the following precedure and order as under:





How to Reach IULER




IIULER is well connected to two international airports: Goa Dabolim
