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A Word About **IIULER**

The Bar Council of India through its Trust, after having successfully established the National Law School of India University, Bangalore in 1986, has established the India International University of Legal Education and Research, Goa (IIULER) in the year 2022, to bring about the next landmark revolution in the field of legal Education.

The first revolution was by way of introduction of the 5 year Integrated Law Degree course through NLSIU, Bangalore, which is now a rage amongst students. This revolution by the name of IIULER is set to harmonize, amalgamate and integrate theory, research, clinical/practical training, legal skill acumen, aptitude & social consciousness amongst its students, as never witnessed before, in the landscape of Indian Legal Education. This can make them emerge as fully equipped with all tools to practise law and/or to pursue higher studies and/or to appear in judicial exams, job interviews in Govt. and/ or pvt. in firms and corporate offices etc. on the day they graduate.

Bar Council of India is the regulator of legal education in India. Owing to the growing demand of reforming the quality of legal education in the country, the Bar Council of India, Trust – PEARL FIRST established a model University of International standards that can be the blueprint/illustrative for other institutions in India imparting legal education.

This 'Gen-Next' institution strives to meet Global academic standards and nurture leaders of tomorrow with its innovative use of clinical learning methods by establishing a connect between academic legal studies and actual implementation of law. All modern subjects and techniques with practical experiential learning are available in the University. Apart from providing strong academic foundation, the academic teaching, here, is interlinked and well connected with Bar and the Bench. The institution believes that adherence to academic and personal conduct, based on integrity, honesty and fairness, is highly essential to nurture the budding lawyers of tomorrow.



1857 – Universities of Calcutta, Madras & Bombay started teaching of law subjects.
1948 – Radhakrishnan Commission assessed the state of University Education and made its recommendations for improvement.

The Radhakrishnan Committee's recommendations had an impact on legal education institutions. The Fourteenth Report of the First Law Commission (1955–1958) commented on the poor state of legal education in the country and emphasized the need for its reform.

1961 – Bar Council of India was entrusted with the responsibility of Legal Education. BCI started setting standards for Legal Education for 3 year LL.B. Degree courses and in 1986 established National Law School of India University, Bengaluru, as a model law school with an innovative Five-year Integrated Programme. The unique experiment of National Law School of India University, Bengaluru, gave a new life to the field of legal education.

The era of National Law Universities started in India with the establishment of second National Law University, i.e. NALSAR, Hyderabad, in 1998, which was followed by a flurry of National Law Universities (26 and still counting). As of now, BCI has established, a truly International University in the form of INDIA INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF LEGAL EDUCATION & RESEARCH, at GOA, INDIA, in the year 2021-2022.

IIULER Act

IIULER is established by Goa Government by way of an enactment known as India International University of Legal Education & Research of the Bar Council of India Trust at Goa Act (Act No. 16 of 2021) and the University takes pride to be the first International Law University in India established by the Bar Council of India Trust – PEARL FIRST.

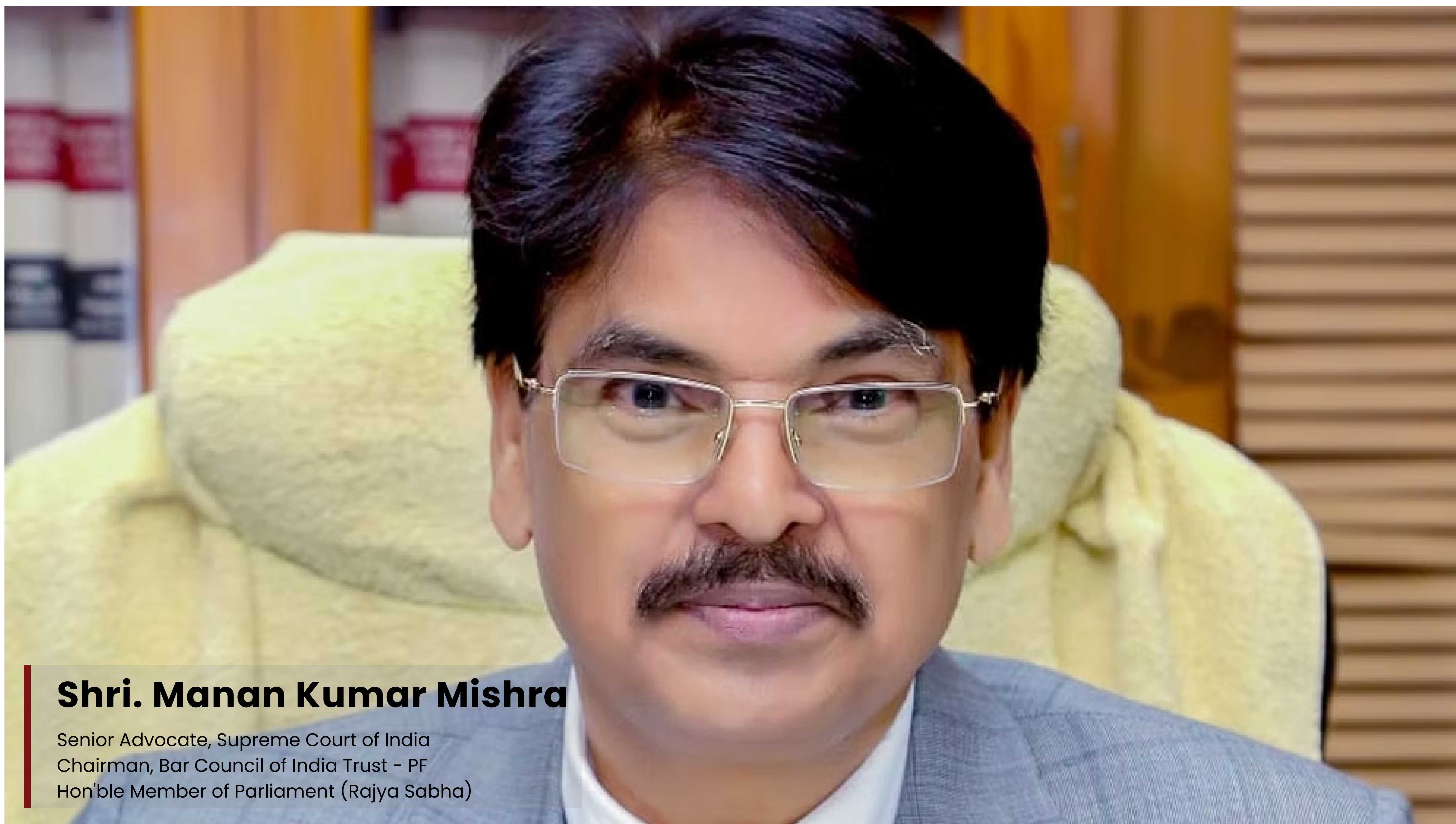
OUR VISION

Special Bridge Courses

IIULER-Goa is an exclusive institution to offer bridge course programmes for Indian nationals holding foreign law degrees. This entitles the degree holder to practise in India. Candidates who have been permitted by the BCI to pursue the Bridge Course, at IIULER, Goa, may apply for the course.

CLAT 2026 UG General Instructions

- Indian Nationals/NRIs seeking admission to the UG programmes can appear in CLAT 2026.
- Foreign Nationals are not eligible to appear for CLAT.
- For information regarding NRI/NRI Sponsored/Foreign National seats, the applicants are advised to contact the University via email at info@iiuler.edu.in or visit the [official website](#) for further details.
- Information regarding the details of intake, reservation policies and the courses offered along with the fee structures are available in this Information Brochure which can be accessed from the official website.
- Candidates are advised to visit CLAT 2026 website regularly for updates.

UG Eligibility Criteria

- There is no upper age limit for candidates appearing for UG Programme through the CLAT 2026.
- Candidates who have passed in 10+2 or an equivalent examination with a minimum of:
 - i. Forty five percent (45%) of marks or its equivalent in grade
- The result of the qualifying examination (i.e., 10+2) shall be submitted by the candidate at the time of admission, failing which the candidate shall be ineligible for admission to the course they may have applied for.
- Candidates appearing for the qualifying examination in March/ April, 2026 are also eligible to apply. However, they shall be required to produce an evidence of their passing the qualifying examination at the time of admission, failing which they shall lose their right to be considered for admission.
- If more than one candidate secures an equal number of marks in the CLAT 2026, the break of tie shall be by the following procedure and order as under:
 - i. Higher marks in the component/section on Legal Aptitude in the CLAT 2026 exam;
 - ii. Higher age;
 - iii. Computerised draw of lots.
- Available number of seats for B.A. LL.B (Hons.) (02 sections) – 120,
B.B.A. LL.B (Hons.) (01 section) – 60

PG Eligibility Criteria

- An LL.B. Degree or an equivalent examination with a minimum of Fifty percent (50%) marks or its equivalent grade in case of candidates belonging to General/OBC/NRI categories.
- Candidates appearing for their qualifying examination in April/May 2026 are also eligible to apply.
- There is no upper age limit for appearing for the CLAT 2026.
- Tie Breaker Rule : In case of equal marks, the break of tie shall be by the following procedure and order as under:
 - i. Higher age;
 - ii. Computerised draw of lots.
- Available number of seats for LL.M (01 section) – 40

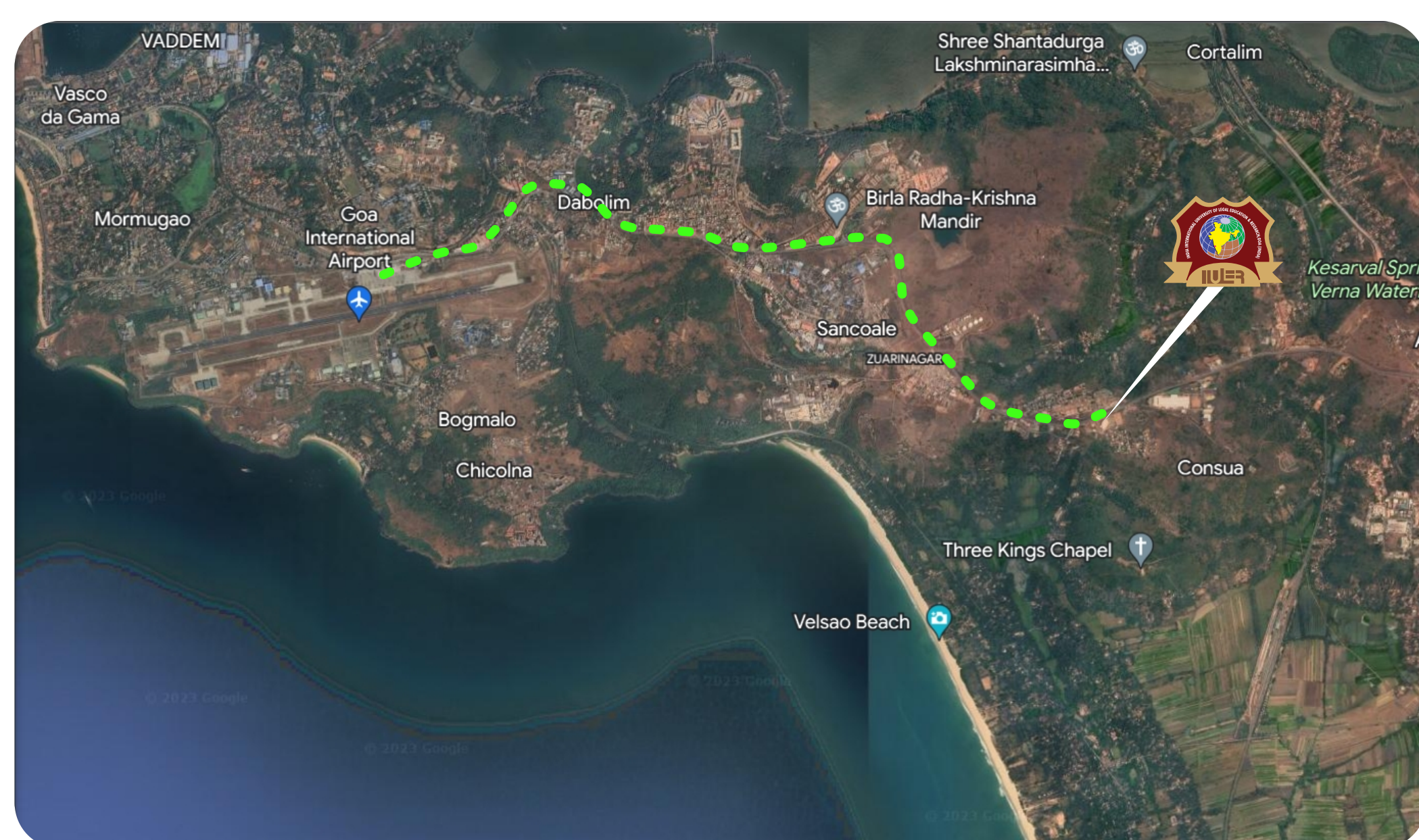

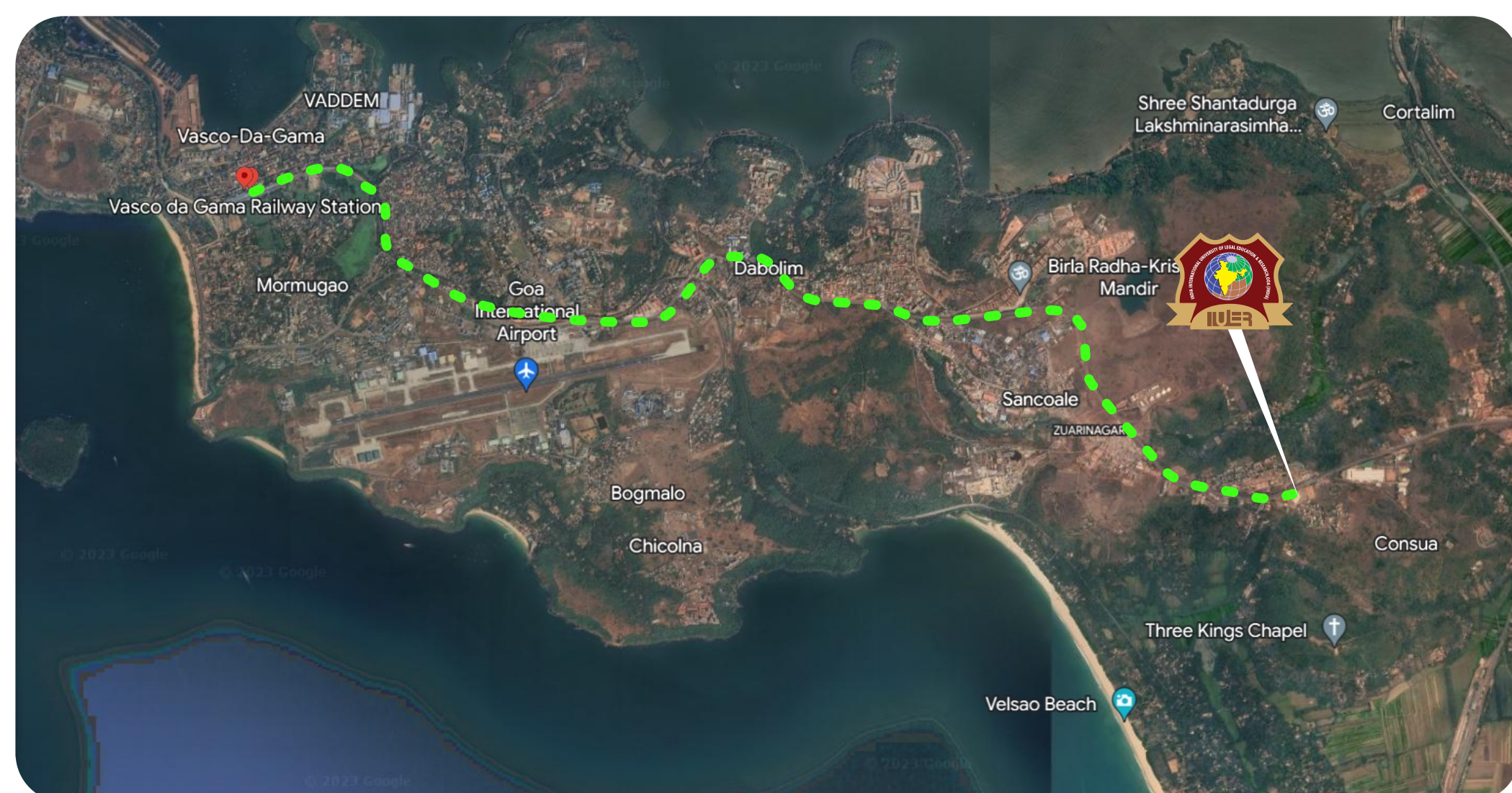
About God

Inter-state bus services are also available from Goa.

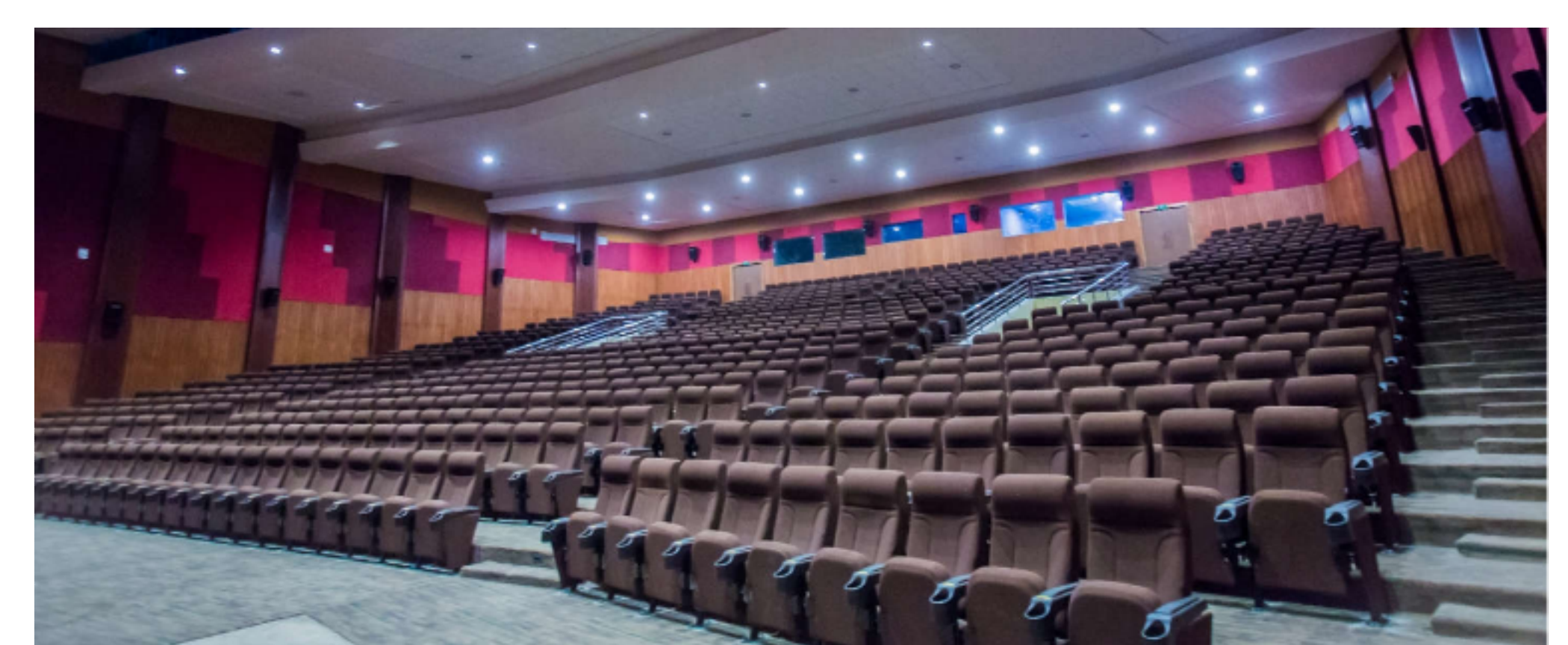
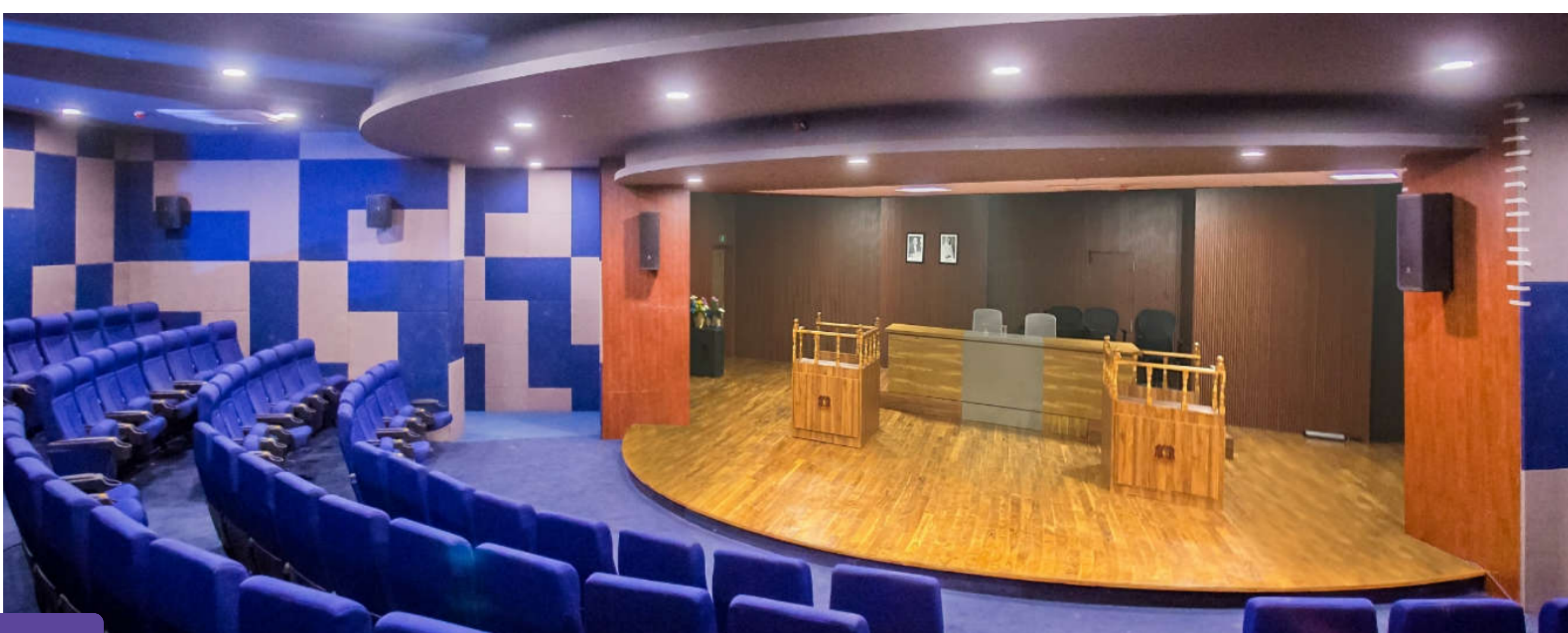
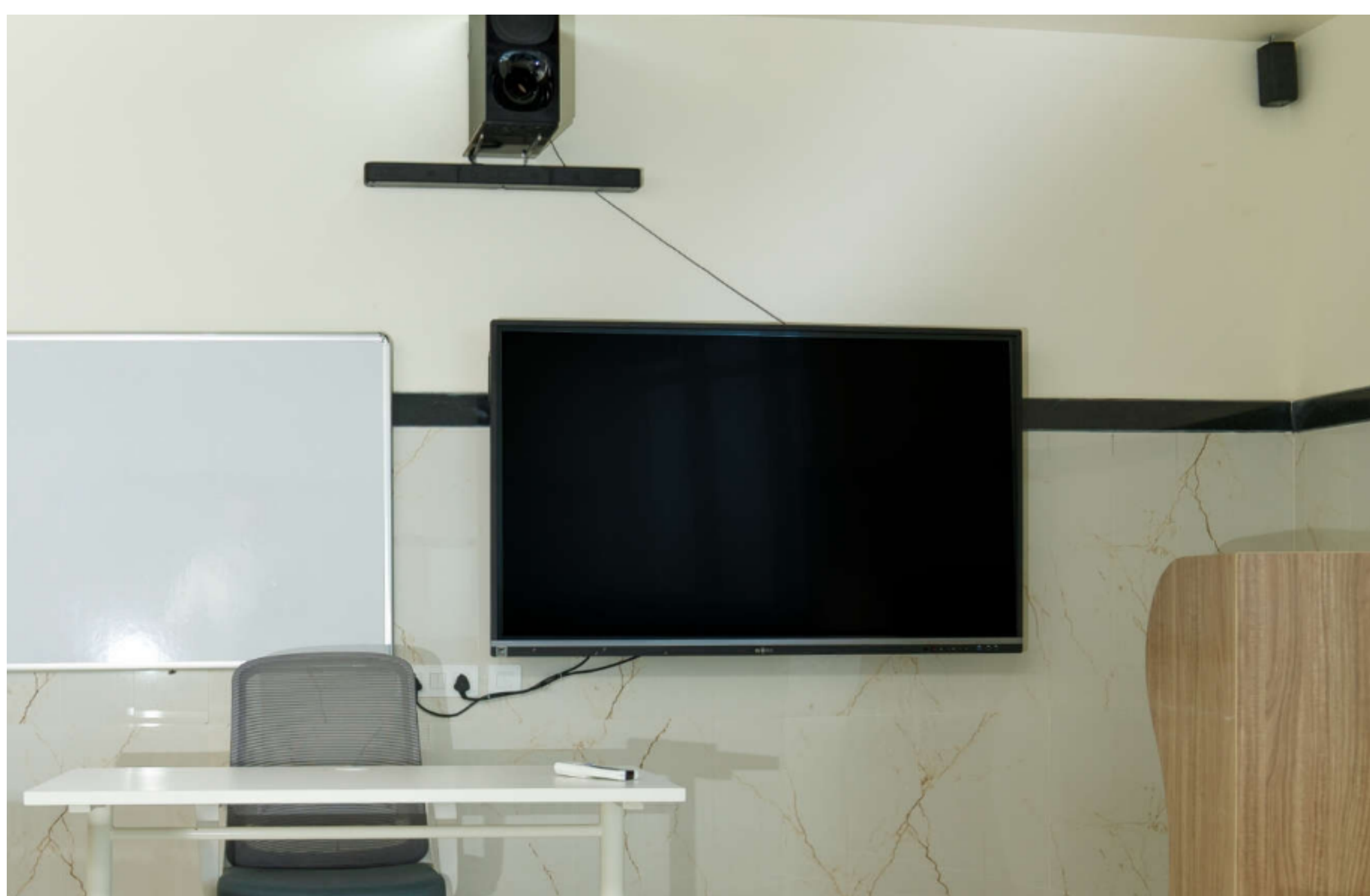
